ACTEW is inviting you to a presentation on its plans to upgrade the Cotter Avenue Recreation Area. This is a key element in ACTEW's rehabilitation of the Cotter Precinct as part of the Enlarged Cotter Dam project.

Since January 2010, Cotter Avenue has been closed to the public due to its proximity to the Enlarged Cotter Dam construction site. To provide alternative recreation options in the Cotter Precinct for the community, ACTEW upgraded Casuarina Sands and built the Cotter Dam Discovery Trail.

ACTEW now plans to upgrade Cotter Avenue, including improved facilities and a Development Application for a new footbridge over the Cotter River. Works to upgrade Cotter Avenue will start later this year for completion in early 2012. Your interest and feedback on these initiatives are most welcome.
